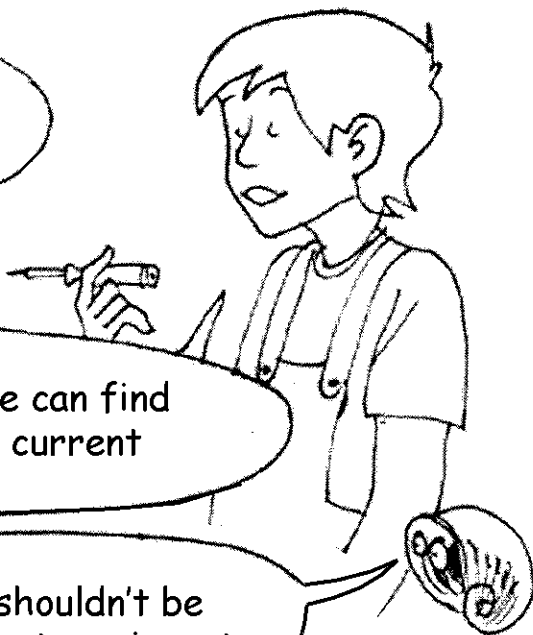

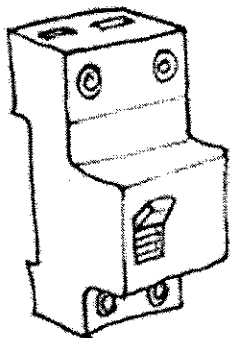


So now we know

ELECTRICITY

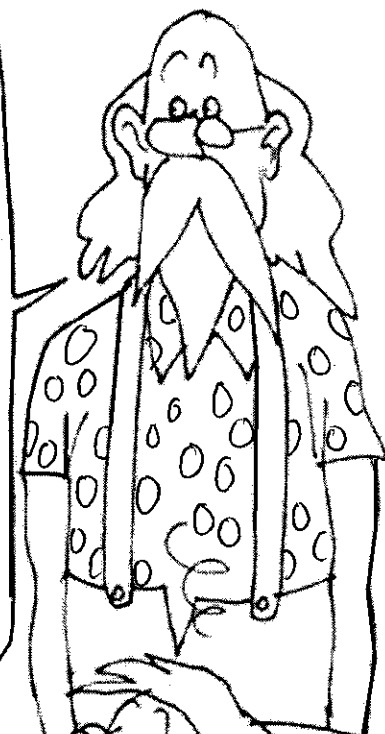


With this test screwdriver we can find

To be complete, we'll finish by
mentioning the **DIFFERENTIAL
CIRCUIT BREAKER**. This is an
electromagnetic apparatus that
controls the absolute values that
pass through the live and neutral
when an installation is being
supplied with electricity. If the
apparatus detects a difference
of 10 to 20 milliamperes, it means
that there is a current leak
somewhere so the circuit-breaker
automatically cuts the current off
